This grant was created by the Advancing the Mission campaign to provide leadership development to include:

- Priestly study for advanced degrees
- Recruitment and education for deacons
- Assistance in the education of seminarians toward ordination
- Recruitment and education of new pastoral leaders
- Promotion and support of lay ecclesial vocations such as pastoral associates, religious education directors, parish business managers, youth ministers and any other lay ecclesial ministries.

- Grant cycle opens: October 1
- Grant cycle closes: December 1
- Applicant Notification of Outcomes: Spring
- If Awarded, Grant Checks Mailed: Before June 30

- Average awards are between \$1,000 - \$5,000.
