This grant was created by the Advancing the Mission campaign to provide for lifelong catechesis to help fund:

- Religious education at the parish/vicariate level in the form of learning materials and teaching stipends
- Tuition assistance to qualified families at Catholic schools
- Direct assistance to Catholic schools in need
- Current work of the Department of Education inclusive of Adult Faith Formation

Important Dates

- Grant cycle opens: October 1
- Grant cycle closes: December 1
- Applicant Notification of Outcomes: Spring
- If Awarded, Grant Checks Mailed: Before June 30

- Sample project requests include Family nights for religious education programs, tuition assistance for families at Catholic schools and enrolled in parish religious education programs, learning materials, and teaching stipends for religious education programs.

Average Grant Awards

- Average awards are between \$1,000 - \$2,500.
