

Lumen Christi Grant

The Lumen Christi endowment is the result of the first major Diocesan fundraising effort in the Diocese of Green Bay, conducted in 1988. Since its inception, Lumen Christi has distributed more than \$27 million in assistance. This includes an annual distribution to every parish in the Diocese for their Religious Education Program. It also includes an annual distribution to every Catholic school and school system in the Diocese of Green Bay to offset the cost of Catholic Schools. There is also a scholarship grant available to provide:

Tuition assistance for academic development of educational leaders, whether in religious education programs or a Catholic school. This includes Master of Theology and Master of Educational Administration programs.

- Grant cycle closes: December 1
- Applicant Notification of Outcomes: Spring

Your grant application must have approval from your supervisor to be considered for funding.

Grant Award Information

- Average scholarship awards vary.
- Awardee is responsible for submitting tuition bill to Nicole Skarda, Grant Coordinator at the Catholic Foundation. Please email tuition bill to nskarda@cfgbwi.org.
- Scholarship awards towards the tuition bill are paid directly to the educational institution the awardee attends.
- Awardee is responsible for paying any remaining balance not covered by the Lumen Christi grant.
- Awardee is expected to work/serve in the Diocese of Green Bay in a leadership position for three years after receipt of the grant.
