Catholic School Facilities Grant

This grant was created by the *one by One* campaign to provide support and assistance to benefit Pre-K through Grade 12 Catholic school facilities within the Diocese of Green Bay.

- Requests must indicate significant repairs, maintenance and upgrade needed at the Catholic school to advance learning
- Requests may strengthen school technology to support hybrid teaching in virtual classrooms as well as introduce innovative instructional models. These requests may provide opportunities for schools to band together to increase offerings that would be cost prohibitive if accomplished on their own.

Please note: This grant is intended to provide seed grants and not fully-fund any particular project, but may fully fund a project on a case-by-case basis.

 - Application window: September 2 - March 15
 - Application window: March 16 – September 1
- Applicant Notification of Outcomes:
 - June
 - November

Please note: An application must be submitted for each facility by an employee of the organization who owns the facility. A parish trustee may also submit an application for parishes who own the school building.
