Preference will be given to applicants whose families are registered at a Catholic parish in the Diocese of Green Bay and have tuition assistance needs.

- Grant cycle closes: December 1
- Applicant Notification of Outcomes: Spring
- If Awarded, Grant Checks Mailed: Before June 30

- Average awards are \$2,000 - \$5,000.
