



Homeless Services Grant

This grant was created by the *one by One* campaign to provide support and assistance to homeless shelters and homeless service providers, including Catholic schools or parishes with programs or ministries serving homeless populations. Grants will be awarded based on:

- Projected impact of the specific issue being addressed
- Ability of the solution to be scaled and replicated for other service providers, and
- Alignment of the project to the teachings of the Catholic Church and the mission and vision of the Diocese of Green Bay.

Important Dates

- Grant cycle opens: October 1
- Grant cycle closes: December 1
- Applicant Notification of Outcomes: Spring
- If Awarded, Grant Checks Mailed: Before June 30

Typical Applicants within the Diocese of Green Bay

- Parishes
- Catholic Schools
- Homeless shelters or organizations serving the homeless

Average Grant Awards

- Average awards are \$500 - \$2,500
