Please take the following simple steps to promote the World's Poor collection in your parish:

- <u>Announce</u> the World's Poor collection in your parish. Please inform your parishioners what the collection is for, when to expect it, and why they should support it.
- Share bulletin announcements, intercessions, and collection envelopes.
- <u>Pray</u> that those living in poverty are comforted, lifted, and receive a lasting opportunity to preserve their human dignity through meaningful work.

The World's Poor Collection supports the following Catholic agencies:

- <u>Catholic Campaign for Human Development</u> Brings change to communities across the country and empowers those living in poverty to transform their communities into reflections of the Kingdom of God.
- <u>Catholic Relief Services</u> Provides emergency assistance to victims of war and natural disasters and supports travelers, others whose livelihoods require special pastoral support to access the sacraments, and victims of human trafficking.
- <u>Peter's Pence</u> Supports the charitable works of Pope Francis. Their initiatives provide
 the Holy Father with the financial means to reach out to people suffering from war,
 oppression, natural disaster, and disease.
- <u>Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa</u> Empowers the Church to fulfill its mission as peacemaker to those who have most suffered fear and violence.
